



State Gross Domestic Product (GDP) since 2010





Job openings by month, June 2008 – Dec. 2023




### **GENERAL FUND STABLE OVER LAST DECADE**

### General Fund Appropriations







### OIL AND GAS TAX PROJECTIONS








### **MOTOR VEHICLE EXCISE TAX**


### INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAX




FOUR MAJOR TAX TYPES – MODEST INCREASE




### BASE BUDGET CALCULATION
